St John's @ 150

We are grateful for a wonderful celebration weekend sharing stories of God's faithfulness over the past 150 years at St John's.

As we look to the future, we are excited to have launched **The Next 150 Project** – our plan to renew and strengthen St John's for the next generation. Over the coming months we'll be raising funds to **plug our current £60,000 budget deficit** and to reach our **£800,000 project goal**. We began with **£220,000**, and since launching last

weekend we've already received **£4,000 toward the deficit** and **£21,000 toward the project** through donations and the sale of mugs, brochures, and blankets.
